## Our Most Relevant Projects:



### INTERCOONECTA

INTERCOONECTA- AECID's knowledge management plan as its cooperation activity. AECID-CEDET agreement to develop a portal that manages the Plan as well as training activities and creation of Knowledge Thematic Communities.



### Virtual Training Plan of Public Administrations in Latin America

Financed by AECID, this plan includes the development of 54 online courses and the dynamization of 11 virtual networks of experts in different topics related to the public sector



### SG-SICA-Security (Police Training)

The General Secretariat of the Central American Integration System promoted this project with the support of the EU and the Spain-SICA Fund, in which CEDET managed the on-site training of 262 police forces of the region.



### The Integration Capacity Building Program of the Inter-American Development Bank

Its objective is to support the global and regional integration of Latin America and the Caribbean in the areas of trade and customs, seeking to create and sustain a critical mass of trained and sensitized civil servants on the needs and opportunities of the process. Since 2011, 147 courses have been taught and 5,679 professionals from the sector have been trained from 676 organizations in the LAC region. In the year 2016 a further 1,563 professionals were trained through 38 online courses.



### WB-Platform for the improvement of sustainable infrastructures in LA (KPESIC)

In 2016 KPESIC developed webinars, virtual workshops and work groups, which have already reached the 5,000 registered users. In this way, it fulfills its objective of serving as a meeting point for the public, private and academic sectors on issues related to infrastructure and sustainability in the region (roads, water, ports and airports, etc.). In addition, it has extended its institutional collaboration to universities, companies and various public bodies.



### SICA Virtual Training Program on Regional Integration in Central America

The SICA Virtual Training Program on Regional Integration in Central America began its third phase in 2016 with the objective of contributing to the strengthening of the Central American integration process through training actions and the exchange of experiences, oriented to the improvement of the technical capacities and knowledge of the officials and civil servants of SICA and of other actors involved. In order to fulfill this objective, the program has an online space for professionals linked to the Central American Integration process in any of its 5 basic pillars: Comprehensive Disaster Risk Management and Climate Change, Democratic Security, Social Integration, Economic Integration and Institutional strengthening. At present, there are more than 2,000 professionals formed virtually of which 676 are part of the Virtual Network on Integration managed by CEDET for the SG-SICA.



### National Federation of Coffee Growers of Colombia

the CEDET Foundation develops this project for the National Federation of Coffee Growers of Colombia with the objective of improving the sustainability of the natural environment where coffee is grown and the living conditions of the farmers who dedicate themselves to it. CEDET has created a virtual space where producers, academia, public sector and companies share knowledge and experiences



### Xcala

is a platform to catalyze investment in early stages whose general objective is to increase the access to finance of dynamic ventures through networks of investors in Latin America and the Caribbean. Xcala was born as part of an alliance between the Institute of Business Studies of Montevideo (IEEM) and the Multilateral Investment Fund (FOMIN), member of the IDB Group. CEDET implements online training actions within the platform adapted to the needs of entrepreneurs

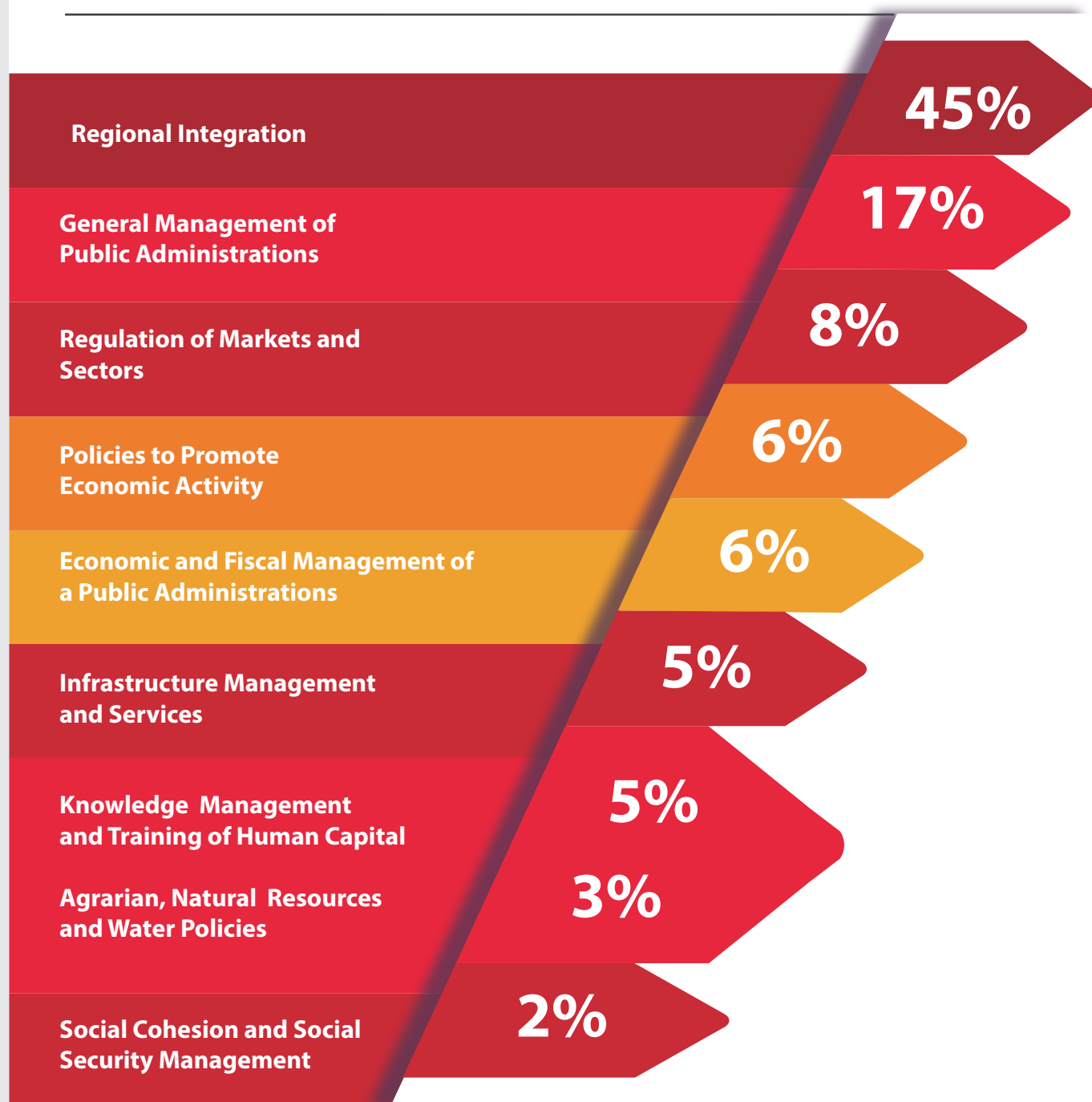

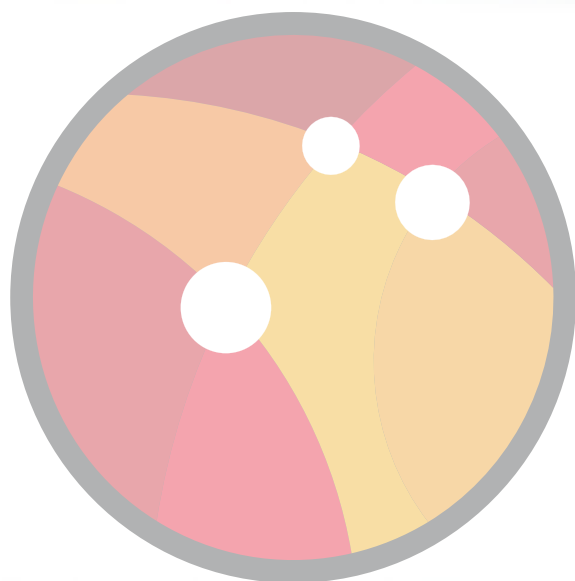
